



The World Outside – Privacy Policy

1 Statement of intent

The purpose of this policy is to be transparent about how The World Outside will collect, use and protect the personal information you provide to us, whether online, via phone, email, in letters or in any other correspondence.

Personal data is information that relates to identifiable living individuals. The World Outside will act in accordance with current legislation and meet current best practice with regard to the processing of personal data. We are committed to safeguarding your personal information.

2 Collection of personal data

In any contact you have with The World Outside, you may provide certain personal data to us which we will compile and process in accordance with this Privacy Policy. By providing such information you agree to its use and storage in accordance with the provisions of this Privacy Policy. For example, this might occur when you engage with our social media, buy merchandise / tickets, register for an event or otherwise provide us with personal information. When you do so, we may ask for personal information, like your name, email address and telephone number.

The World Outside will collect details on participants in order that they can take part in activities in order to comply with safe guarding and contacting next of kin in case of an emergency. Without details of relevant medical conditions, emergency contact numbers, special needs, and the necessary consents, the World Outside may not be able to safeguard the needs of the participants.

2.1 Debit and credit card information

The World Outside does not retain any financial data. We use Ticket Source, Gocardless and Sum up to collect payments. The World Outside will continue to monitor these companies to ensure that they are compliant with the General Data Protection requirements.

3 How we use your personal data

The World Outside will only use your data for the purposes for which it is provided or where there is a lawful basis. For example by providing your name, address, email address and telephone number we are able to contact you about your bookings or news and events which you may be interested in.

When we collect and use your personal information, we will make sure this is only done accordance with at least one of the legal grounds available to us under Data Protection law. One of these is where we have obtained your specific consent to use your information for a previously notified purpose, such as to send you email/text marketing or to provide you with a product, service or information at your request.

Another is where we have a legal obligation to use or disclose information about you or in order to pass on the information you have provided us with to the emergency services.

In certain instances, we may collect and use personal information where this is necessary in our legitimate interest, this includes being able to:

- send marketing material via e-mail about our work
- conduct research to better understand who our customers are
- maintain and administer our visitor database

In all cases, we balance our legitimate interests against your rights as an individual and make sure we only use personal information in a way or for a purpose that you would reasonably expect in accordance with this Policy and that does not intrude on your privacy or previously expressed marketing preferences.

Where we process sensitive personal data (as mentioned above), we will make sure that we only do so in accordance with one of the additional lawful grounds for processing such as where we have your explicit consent or you have made that information manifestly public. When we do this, we will tell you what sensitive personal data we are collecting and why.

3.1 Marketing material

3.1.1 Email marketing

If you actively provide your consent to us along with your email address we may contact you for marketing purposes by email. By subscribing to The World Outside emails or opting in to email communication from The World Outside, you grant us the right to use the email for the purposes specified when you opt-in.

We use mail chimp to send our newsletters and information on activities

3.1.2 Your choices

It is always your choice as to whether you want to receive information about us. If you do not want us to use your personal information in this way please indicate your preferences when we collect your data.

We will not use your personal information for email marketing purposes if you have indicated that you do not wish to be contacted by us for such purposes. You may opt-out of our email marketing communications at any time by clicking the 'unsubscribe' link in at the end of our marketing emails or by contacting us as detailed in section 5 below. At any time you may opt-out of all marketing communications choices using the contact details given in Section 5.

3.2 Third parties

We will only use your information within The World Outside for the purposes for which it was obtained. The World Outside will not, under any circumstances, share or sell your personal data with any third party for marketing purposes and you will not receive offers from other companies or organisations as a result of giving your details to us.

4 Storage and correction of personal data

We will hold your personal information on our systems for as long as is necessary for the relevant activity.

If you request that we stop sending you marketing materials we will keep a record of your contact details and appropriate information to enable us to comply with your request not to be contacted by us.

The accuracy of your information is really important to us. We want to ensure that we are able to communicate with you in ways that you are happy with, and to provide you with information that is of interest.
