The Mud Kitchen

Measurement, mixing, and role-play. Developing fine motor skills and social collaboration through messy play.



Clay Critters

Moulding, shaping, and imaginative design. Developing fine motor strength, creativity, and problem-solving through hands-on, sensory exploration

Real-world cooking using heat and tools. Supporting communication, scientific understanding, and risk awareness through shared practical tasks

Leaf beating, hapazome, and charcoal drawing. Using nature as both calico and tool for expression.
